When your money makes aliyah

Dear Daniel

I am making aliyah next year. What is the best way of moving my funds to Israel?

Simon

Dear Simon,

The first piece of advice I give clients before making aliyah is to make sure they have access to their funds once they have made the move.

What I mean by this is that when you want access to your sterling held in the UK, the bank will let you send the money. Online banking

often has limits on amounts you can send, and some online banking facilities don't let you send money overseas. So, before you make aliyah, speak to the bank and make sure they will allow you to send funds to yourself without being in the country.

When sending money to Israel, the banks

there charge you to receive the money, a commission to convert the funds and offer you a poor exchange rate.

If you use a licensed foreign exchange company in Israel, you can avoid the receiving and commission charges and get a better exchange rate.
